SHERWOOD FOREST SIGN MAINTENANCE



This summer, SFCC had both entry signs inspected and restored by a wood restoration company. Bottom and tops of north and south sign posts were treated to prevent wood rot. Both of the sign post arm were lifted and re-shimmed with pressure treated wood.

These signs were carved in the 1960s, specifically for the Sherwood Forest neighborhood by world renowned Northwest wood carver Dudley Carter.

FALL MAINTENANCE CHECKLIST

- Check or Replace batteries in smoke detectors.
- Replace furnace/AC filters.
- Check the heating system, chimney, and fireplace.
- Clean gutters and downspouts.
- Inspect windows, doors, weatherstripping, and trim.
- Inspect the insulation and ventilation.
- Landscape the yard and prune as needed.
- Fertilize and aerate your lawn to prepare for next year.
- Overseed the lawn and attack perennial weeds.
- Clean and pressure wash walkways and driveways.
- Seal the deck, fix gates, and store or cover outdoor furniture and equipment.
- Repair any drainage issues.
- Winterize your sprinkler system
